MINUTES
 General Meeting
 Sept. 8, 2012

- I. President Tina Briones welcomed the members at 11 a.m. Members heard the secretary's report and the minutes from the last meeting were approved by three members.
- II. Treasurer Marcie Helmke reported that our current balance is \$20,434.84. She reported that fiduciary responsibility remains a crucial part of all officers' jobs.
- III. Sandra de Leon has resigned her position as Director, so there was no Director's report. Tina announced that there will be an election to fill the open position at the December meeting. Anyone interested in running for the office should let Secretary Julie Mihalko know so that his or her name can be placed on the ballot.
- IV. Mr. Rodriguez from RBFCU spoke to the members about qualifying for membership as ATPE members. Members received promotional items from the credit union.
- V. Tina presented the budget to the members and it was accepted after a motion was made by Diana Bush and seconded by Rosa Linda Santoyo.
- VI. President Briones invited members to sign up to serve on committees as the sign-up sheets were distributed. She also emphasized the importance of getting new members to sign up no later than Sept. 30, 2012 to qualify for full, immediate benefits.
- VII. Future meeting dates were discussed. The next meeting will be held at Dave and Busters on Dec. 1, then we will meet Feb. 16 at Golden Wok, and we will end with our May meeting at Dave and Buster's. Lobby Day is on February 10-11, 2013.

- VIII. If a local unit requires financial help to attend the Summit, they must apply to the Region by May 4, 2013. The packet members received has a form to apply for help.
- IX. Past President Byron Hildebrand is in charge of organizing teams to participate in the Foundation golf tournament. Contact him by Oct. 26, 2012.
- X. To finish up the old business, there is a \$50 local incentive per meeting. An officer must sign for it or it will be mailed to the president of the local unit. The \$165 per voting member at the summit will be given if the member attends both the region caucus and the entire House of Delegates.
- XI. Door prizes were awarded and the meeting was adjourned at 1:15 p.m.
