ATPE stresses the importance of teachers voting their profession

KILLEEN, Texas – “It’s time for teachers to vote their profession” will be the message delivered to area educators Saturday during a regional meeting of the Association of Texas Professional Educators. Newly appointed ATPE Executive Director Gary Godsey will address the group at 10 a.m. on the Texas A&M University–Central Texas campus.

In addition to outlining his vision for the state’s largest education association, Godsey will stress the need for educators to elect pro-public education lawmakers.

All members of the media are welcome to attend and interview Godsey about the upcoming primary election and the importance of teachers casting votes based on what is best for public education. Constituting a potential voting bloc of 637,000 voters, Texas public educators could change the outcome of any state or local election if they voted their profession.
